Software Identification Summit

Overview

This summit is designed to provide a forum for all software ecosystem members to discuss the future of software identification and discuss how these issues can be addressed in an authoritative fashion today with existing tools and technology. We will work through details on how the software community is actively solving this age old problem both for legacy as well as new software products.

Background

Software identification today is much more of an art than science. Multiple tools attempt to identify software based on a variety of inputs. However, these products produce different and/or inconclusive results either because software products are difficult to identify, or because of limitations on a particular computing platform or toolset.

Accurate software identification is required for most IT and many business processes including software asset management, patch management, desktop management, help desk, data security assessments and network security. Accurate software identification is also required for policy, contractual and/or regulatory compliance.

The ISO/IEC 19770-2:2009 standard defines a structure for software identification and specifies how information should be provided by publishers and/or providers. TagVault.org provides registration and certification procedures to normalize this data as well as tools and services that turn software identification into a science with explicitly defined outcomes.
